

The Ralph C. and Sue Quellhorst Program for Leadership Endowment Fund
Scholarship for United Church Homes

Purpose:

The resources from this Endowment Fund shall be used toward assisting UCH in advancing it's educational and staff leadership development missions.

Policy:

Scholarships will be based on availability of funds each year as reported to the Quellhorst Scholarship Committee from the Advancement Department of United Church Homes at the beginning of each year. The Quellhorst Scholarship Committee will promote and publicize the Scholarship Program with UCH staff and other key individuals as applicable.

Individuals receiving scholarships from this fund will be recognized as Quellhorst Fellows. Scholarships will be granted in support of:

- Staff Education and Leadership Development (non-degree opportunities)
- Professional Internships (for undergrad and graduate students)
- Pastoral Leadership Development (CPE & field placement)
- Minority Leadership Development

To qualify:

For United Church Homes Staff Education and Leadership Development

- 1) Be a full time or part time employee of United Church Homes and completed one full year of service in an eligible employment status
- 2) Have endorsement of immediate supervisor for professional development or continuing education opportunity

For Pastoral Leadership Development:

- 1) Be a current or prospective student in the Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) program
- 2) Be a seminary student or ordained Pastor seeking experience working in a Senior Living setting
- 3) Have endorsement of faculty advisor, field placement office and pastoral staff at ministry setting

For Professional Internship requests:

- 1) Have endorsement of immediate Supervisor after preparing a case for support (see separate application)
